Kew Gardens

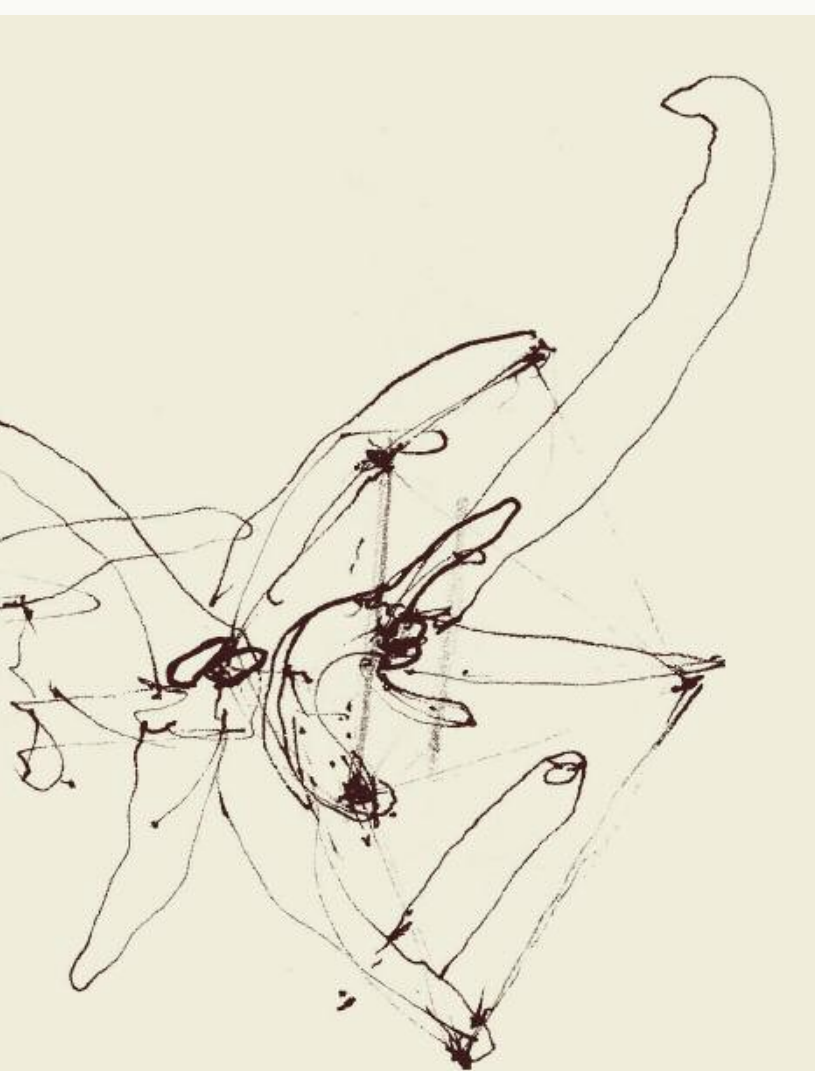
Sunday • June 9th 11am - 3.00 pm
